



New CPA Exam launched on Jan. 1, 2024.

CPA EVOLUTION

Core + Discipline Model:

- The CPA Evolution Exam will include three core exams and one discipline exam of your choosing (max = 4 sections)
- Technology knowledge and skills will be tested in all sections
- Candidates don't have the option to pass additional disciplines



CPA EXAM ELIGIBILITY

Texas CPA Exam candidates are now eligible to begin testing at 120 hours of education credit, including 21 hours of upper-level accounting.



Notice to Schedule in Texas extended from 90 days to 180 days, effective Jan. 1, 2024.



Expiration of exam credits extended from 18 months to 30 months, effective Jan. 1, 2024.



Applicant Reassessment Program from the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy invites those who lost exam credits between Jan. 1, 2020, and Jan. 1, 2024, due to expiration to reach out for potential reinstatement of those credits.

TEXAS STATE BOARD OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY SCHOLARSHIP

Expanded eligibility for applicants that makes scholarship funds available to accounting students who have taken at least 15 hours of upper-level accounting coursework.
