CareerSpring FORWARD

The CareerSpring FORWARD Program is a short-term experiential internship opportunity for FGLI students. This early career identification program helps participants discover their strengths and interests, explore potential career options that align with their goals, and inspire confidence in their abilities as they prepare for future career opportunities—an experience not often afforded to FGLI students.

The labor market is rapidly evolving and FGLI talent is increasingly critical for the future of our economy. Research shows that students who have an internship are 49% less likely to be underemployed at graduation, and we want to ensure that CareerSpring Advisees are connected to internship opportunities that help shape their future.





How To Get Involved

While employers are struggling to find the next generation of talent, the majority of FGLI students find it difficult to break into the professional workforce. This unique program allows companies to partner with CareerSpring and our Network to engage with the next generation of talent earlier in their college and career journey.

Your company can be a part of the solution by hosting a cohort of interns. This three-week program's framework will be developed in partnership with CareerSpring, and will be easy to execute, scalable, replicable, and an overall valuable experience for all involved.

CareerSpring FORWARD Program Details

Each year, CareerSpring FORWARD welcomes a cohort of interns in the summer before their sophomore or junior year of college to participate in a three-week paid internship. Interns receive an introduction to the industry, shadowing opportunities, work on an industry-focused project, attend presentations and training by industry experts, and complete a capstone presentation.

Interns are divided into three industry-focused cohorts: Accounting and Finance, IT and Data Analytics, and Marketing. CareerSpring has developed a program that is low cost and easy to execute for companies of all sizes, while also creating an opportunity to make an impact on local FGLI students.




